Whilst the celebrations have been going on we have continued with our day work too though;

- Our amazing Street Teams have seen an increase in the number of people needing help and support.
- At a recent Wednesday lunch one of our staff prayed with an asylum seeker who was desperate for prayer for her epilepsy which she said had been significantly worse since arriving in the UK.
- In Renew we continue to grow our counselling and mindfulness provision. One of the mindfulness attendees hadn't found work for the past 16 years or even had an interview for the last 20 years. He recently had an interview up against 4 other candidates and was successfully employed.
- Louise had a phone call from one of the shelter guests who was in such a good place and is now in accommodation, paying his rent on time and full of hope.

We are really grateful to our GCM Sky Diving Team. The 19 jumpers have had mixed success with the weather


