Restore

We are so excited to announce that Restore has finally opened. We had hoped to have it up and running last November but then with restrictions in place it had to be delayed.

We have converted our original old office in Southgate Street (next to Southgate Evangelical Church) into a place where anyone homeless can come to get clothes, toiletries, shoes and equipment. It is open on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 1-3pm for clients to come and get any items that they need.

This has been a mammoth job led by our Volunteer Coordinator Elaine and will initially be staffed by Jayne and Darren from our Revive Coffee House.
