

Outreach Stories - Donna Adlington

"I have been blessed and very fortunate to have been a Gloucester City Mission volunteer for about 8 years now. Over those years, there have been many changes, and I've been privileged to meet some wonderful people, (both fellow volunteers and street friends). Some of whom are sadly no longer with us, but will always hold a special place in my heart.

It is a real blessing to reach out to those in need, both physically and spiritually, and to work alongside some of the most genuine, and loving Christians you'd ever wish to meet, and at the end of the day, that's exactly what we are called to do. Love! Without borders! Irrelevant of class, race, religion or any other differences, and if there's anything that our street friends really need, it is to feel loved, valued and precious, and hopefully to help them to learn to value themselves and see a teeny tiny glimpse of the love Jesus has for them through us.

Another part of working alongside our street friends which I find so rewarding is signposting. Putting them in touch with other agencies across Gloucester who are each responsible for different area's of care. There's nothing quite like hearing the news that someone has found a home or job, got good veterinary care for their dog, or entered a rehabilitation facility.

But before I downplay the food provision element of outreach, one of my fondest memories is of a guy, who is no longer with us (in case anyone is wondering, although names may not be allowed in print, it was Gary) We were in Kings square, handing out sausage rolls and coffee, and suddenly a huge seagull swooped down and flew off with his sausage roll (paper bag and all). I've never seen anyone respond so quickly, and move so fast. He ran after it at great speed, and as it tried to fly higher, he jumped on a bench and ran straight across it. I'm happy to say he was so relieved to save his lunch! So i guess the food is pretty important too!"


