





Helping the homeless in our city

Thank you for picking up this latest edition of our Newsletter.

Regrettably we must start with bad news and announce that, due to current restrictions, we will not be able to run a Winter Shelter this year.

The Trustees have had to make this decision after consultation with the Local Authority and other agencies and, given that the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government are still advising that; 'Night shelters have to be closed due to the risk of infection in these communal settings...Government advice continues that all communal night shelters should remain closed at the present time', it will not be possible to offer the provision.

This is difficult and frustrating for us as a Mission however we must trust that the Lord has a plan and that He will offer protection to the clients who will need to be provided with alternative support by the council. This council's emergency provision remains in place and they have just received a further £300k funding to support clients.

We have good partnership links with, and will continue to support, the Local Authority and agencies such as P3 by keeping them informed of clients who are unknown to them and by ensuring that we advocate for clients who are in and around Gloucester and not receiving the support they might desperately need.

We will be running our Outreach Teams in the city six days a week from the start of October and this provision will continue all winter as well as Wednesday lunches. There is an Outreach update on page 2.

Please pray that the clients we work with may receive the support that they might need this winter.

We are still pushing ahead with Survive the Night (Virtual Edition) and any money raised will be used for additional resources for the outreach teams over the winter months so that they can reach as many people as possible. Any unspent money will be ring-fenced for next year's shelter. Please sign up for Survive the Night if you haven't already. Revive Coffee House has opened and it has been a great start with long term GCM supporters popping in as well as lots of people who didn't know about our work.

It is a place to come and relax, drink ethically sourced hot drinks, enjoy a cold drink, eat homemade cakes and treats, and find out about our work.

All of our Outreach work now runs out of Revive.

On a Monday and Tuesday we will use the space to run training courses for clients such as basic skills, cookery, crochet club and Alpha Courses.

Outreach Update

We continue to have teams of volunteers out every week day from 10.30-12.30. From the start of October we will also be sending teams out on Saturday mornings.

Teams are able to offer prayer, food, drinks, emergency clothes packs and advice to anyone rough sleeping and are also able to support anyone who is vulnerable.

In August we supported clients on over 500 occasions which means that between June and August we have worked with people directly on the streets over 1750 times. It is looking likely that September's figure will continue to be high as on one day alone we worked with 61 people in the city centre.

Outreach work gives us the opportunity to meet directly with people who are either rough sleeping, sofa surfing or in accommodation. It enables us to build trust of clients who didn't use our services when we ran sessions out of the centre.

It also gives more time to offer prayer to clients who might desperately need it or if they aren't ready for prayer then teams can give out Promises (Bible passages).

Wednesday Lunch - Wednesday lunch is still going well and continues to be a takeaway meal along with emergency toiletry packs, clothes and face masks.
