


It is a place to come and relax, drink ethically sourced hot drinks, enjoy a cold drink, eat homemade cakes and treats, and find out about

On a Monday and Tuesday we will use the space to run training courses for clients such as basic skills, cookery, crochet club and Alpha Courses.

Upstairs is a large kitchen space where we can offer opportunities to clients to come and learn



new skills in a commercial kitchen so that they can hopefully use these skills to find employment. Some of the staff who we employ have experienced homelessness.

You will hopefully have see on our social media pages lots of updates from our John O Groats to Lands End Virtual Challenge. We had a team of 10 people who took up the challenge to raise funds for our outreach work. The team were amazing and we completed the original distance of 882 miles in 8 days, at this point we could have finished the challenge but instead we collectively decided to add on the extra 232 miles to get back to

GCM, thus making the total distance travelled 1114 miles!

Thank you to the whole team for giving their time up and working around work schedules to fit in the hours of exercise, thank you also to everyone who has supported with donations. At the time of writing our total is just over $\pounds 2800$, we would love to get it beyond $\pounds 3000$.

Outreach Update

We continue to have teams of volunteers out every week day from 10.30-12.30. They are able to offer prayer, food, drinks, emergency clothes packs and advice to anyone rough sleeping and are also able to support anyone who is vulnerable.

In July we supported clients on 733 occasions which is up 200 hundred on June's.

Catering Van – Mo, our catering van, gets out and about supporting those clients sleeping rough away from the city centre.

Wednesday Lunch - Wednesday lunch is still going well and continues to be a takeaway meal along with emergency toiletry packs, clothes and face masks.


