A few days later we then had our annual thank you Hog Roast for our amazing volunteers, Staff and Trustees also joined in. Thank you to Matt, The Cotswold Caterer for providing a delicious lunch. Volunteers then had the opportunity to look around Renew and in particular the new Retreat centre.

We have now had a couple of Embrace sessions on a Thursday evening. After a quiet first session with 2 people coming, the other sessions have had 10 people com each week, most of whom came because of what they had heard about it. We pray that those sessions continue to flourish and offer attendees a safe place to come and find Jesus.

Retreat is now open and has been really busy in these first few weeks. Nathan and his team of volunteers have been brilliant with guests. The new centre has food, showers, a laundry, beds, advice and we also now have a podiatry service once a month and a weekly medical clinic. Mears & Gloucester City Mission by Jude Herbert Head of Ledgers & Financial Controls, Mears Group PLC

Mears Group Plc has a strong belief in social value, with the company supporting all employees to take up to a maximum of the equivalent of two working days a year for volunteering in the community.

It can sometimes be hard to find volunteering opportunities at the Gloucester Head Office as it has around 70 staff who all work in the support service functions, accounts, HR, and procurement rather than any of our operational repairs teams. Staff can also feel daunted at the thought of taking an entire day out or were not able to join in due to not working a full day.

The model that Mears has agreed with Gloucester City Mission works well to alleviate people's concerns about time as well as being inclusive for staff who work flexed hours. We volunteer regularly with Gloucester City Mission, sending a team of 2-4 people for a two-hour session. We rotate around activities, so that people have the opportunity to experience different aspects of volunteering. The slots we offer our staff include serving at the weekly hot food service, baking cakes, deep cleans of the kitchen, sorting clothing and we have now added the gardening club to our rota.

Beth from our Recruitment department said "It was a great opportunity volunteering at Gloucester City Mission, they are lovely people working to ensure anyone in need is getting the support, shelter and food needed. I was helping out cleaning their new safe place to ensure it is fully clean and sanitized ready for people in need to use the facilities. It was an excellent experience, and I am so glad I was able to support Gloucester City Mission."

Christine in Payroll also said; "For me it was an enjoyable and rewarding experience and it was lovely to see the people we helped with a smile on their face."
