We are continuing to look at ways to adapt our Winter Shelter provision because the strict restrictions from last year are still going to be in place. We put an offer in on a suitable property over three months ago but communication with the current owners is proving quite slow and we know that there is quite a lot of renovation work that will need carrying out on this property. However we trust that God will provide us with the

answer at the suitable time. This potential property will also enable us to open an Education and Training Centre in the city. The lease we are pursuing is a long term lease so even if plans don't come off this year we know that if it is the right property for us to move into then we will still have lots of years ahead of us to support clients through the winters but also all year around in offering them opportunities to develop themselves, their confidence and independence.

Hopefully you will soon pop into our coffee shop and see the changes that we have put in place in Revive - new tables and chairs, tub chairs, coffee tables, some books, the new coffee machine and even a cup warmer! Ade is also going to add some splashes of colour to the walls. These changes are to celebrate the fact that we now extended our please there for an additional 3 years.

When we opened our Revive Coffee House last August it was a bit of a risk for us and initially we were offered a 12 month lease. Well the great news is that we have now extended that lease for a further 3 years - for this we are incredibly grateful to our landlords; Gloucester City Council as well as to Jason and his team at The Eastgate Shopping Centre who have been so supportive of us being there.

To mark the lease extension we have been busy over this past few weeks making a few changes. We have replaced all of the tables and chairs (thanks to Gloucestershire College), have a new coffee machine which serves a whole range speciality coffees (inc decaf), we now have a wider range of cold drinks including fruit smoothies and our awesome Lou has been making even more varieties of cakes and treats, including more G/F and vegan options).

We have also put in a lounge area at the front of the coffee shop and created a working hub at the back so that if you wanted to get away from the office for a bit then you can come and work there - if you are working then we'll probably keep plying you with coffee too once you have bought your first cup. Coming soon you might also enjoy visiting our Old Fashioned Sweet Shop!

For us though the coffee shop is more than just a place to grab a drink or treat. It is a friendly, safe place for anyone to come to work, relax, meet up with friends or to find someone to chat to.

It is also a place where we can do other things. For example we have just finished an Alpha Course for clients. We also run Art for Wellbeing sessions on a Tuesday afternoon. As well as all of that we use the large commercial kitchen upstairs to run all of our outreach out of.
