Then he gets ready for who ever is in need of a shower, clean clothes, somewhere safe to take a sleep or their laundry dropped off or picked up.

He has some amazing volunteers who support him. The volunteers say he steers the ship. so he is the Captain and they are his crew, and without your crew you can't sail. A great big thank you to all the Retreat Volunteers.

Street Teams.

I know we should be coming into the nicer weather, but our street teams are out on the streets when its raining, snowing, blowing a gale or the sun is shinning. They come in, fill the kettles, stock the trollies put on their blue jackets, pray and off they go walking though Gloucester. Some of you may not know what they do, they know our street family and encourage them to go to Retreat, give out hot drinks and biscuits, promises (scripture), sweeties and pray and record who has been seen. Importantly this is done with a smile, love in their hearts and without judgment. Once back they will Steetlink anyone new sleeping on the street, Steetlink is an amazing tool, down load the app and you can report

anyone Homeless and P3 will then send an outreach worker, this could be the beginning of someone getting accommodation.

Our Street Team's are real warriors.






