
We are in need of clothing and shoes but in particular we desperately need;

It was great to meet with Cllr. Brendon O'Donnell to talk about our work and the role the shelter plays in the city. He is currently campaigning to get a permanent shelter opened all year round. 2



Finally a huge thank you to all of the staff and volunteers that have made this year's Winter Shelter run so smoothly. It has been a difficult winter but it has been another winter where lives have been saved and people have found somewhere safe and warm to come into. Over the next few weeks we shall go through the data to analyse the specifics of who has been in, where they have come from and what support they could/should have received instead of relying on the shelter but for now thank you to everyone who has been involved. The shelter itself has cost us over £56,000 to run this year and we have to fundraise for it all - we don't receive any direct statutory funding for it.

Huge thanks especially to Louise, the shelter Manager, Simon and Nathan the Shelter Team Leads. On top of that we have the rest of the staff team and the countless volunteers. This has been the 7th year we have run a shelter in the city. We have worked more closely than ever with the council to get people the support they need and hopefully as we move forwards we will be able to offer more daytime support too.
