We had well over 100 people sleeping out with ages ranging from 8 to over 80 in our events or in their churches, organisations or companies. We have several schools sleeping out later in the school year.

Those who took part were just experiencing a night of being uncomfortable rather than truly experiencing rough sleeping, but everyone talked about the constant noise and the feeling of vulnerability (as well as snoring), however everyone had their awareness levels raised about what being on the streets might

We really want to keep the event growing and will of course be running it again next year. Please think about taking part either in one of the organised events or at one of the events organised by churches or schools.

The Sleepout is always held over the weekend nearest World Homeless Day (Oct 10th).


WORLD HOMELESS WEEKEND 2022


